

THANET NEXT GEN PROJECT

















PROJECT AIMS

We are looking for the next generation of people who want to work in the sports or leisure industry.

The Next Gen Project will work with young people aged 16-21, to give them a variety of work experience placements in the sport and leisure industry. There will also be the opportunity for each candidate to undertake training courses relevant to their sporting interests and future employment/volunteer motivations.

We will take on a group of 15 young people who would like to pursue working in the sport and leisure sector, they will be split into 3 cohorts of 5 people.

Each young person will spend a term working in each of the 3 companies; Active Community Solutions, Your Leisure and Inclusive Sport. Here they will gain different experiences and skillsets which will prepare them for a potential future career.

Each young person will be able to undertake a section of courses of their choice in a sport they have an interest in, as well as undertaking some training from the Streetgames Academy.

We will provide real work experience, in real environments, where the young people will be mentored each week by experts in the relevant field. Each person will be supported by a mentor from each company throughout their placement.



WORK PLACEMENTS

To work with young people (aged 16-21) to give them a variety of work experience placements in the sport and leisure industry. There will also be the opportunity for each candidate to undertake training courses relevant to their sporting interests and future employment/volunteer motivations.





MENTORING GROUPS

We will take on a group of 15 young people who are passionate about working in the sport and leisure sector, they will be split into 3 cohorts of 5 people. Each cohort and individual will be mentored by industry experts.

REAL LIFE WORK EXPERIENCE

Each young person will spend a 6-8 week block working in each of the 3 partner companies; Total Sports Coaching, Your Leisure and Inclusive Sport. Here they will gain different experiences and skillsets which will prepare them for a potential future career. This will provide real work in experience, in real environments with 3 highly respected local organisations.





QUALIFICATIONS

There will also be an opportunity for candidates who excel to be able to gain qualifications in a variety of different areas that can help them progress into a potential career in sport or leisure, as well as undertaking some training from the Streetgames Academy.

Aged between 16 and 21 with an interest in the sports or leisure industry. Young people who want to gain experience working in an exciting variety of industries using sport to help people.

Reliable and excited by taking on a new challenge.

Enthusiastic about working with a diverse group of people.

Available to volunteer between 2 to 5 hours per week throughout the programme, these hours can be in the daytime, evening or weekends depending on your availability.

We work closely with TSC in the community and schools programmes and part of your placement will be working alongside us and TSC in these programmes.

Each person will get to work in a variety of different areas, with experienced coaching staff as well as a mentor.
